

ORDINANCE NO. 2018-02

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING CERTAIN TRANSPORT OF ALCOHOL AND TO
PROVIDE ENFORCEMENT AND PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Landisburg, Perry County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1. Alcoholic Beverages Prohibited. No person shall transport, carry, possess or have on or about his person or in or about any motor vehicle any alcoholic beverage in or upon the streets, alleys, sidewalks, parks or any other municipally owned or leased public facility within the limits of the Borough of Landisburg, except in the original container with the seal unbroken.

SECTION 2. Violations and Penalties. Any person who violates the provisions of this Part shall, upon conviction before a District Justice, be guilty of a summary offense and shall be subject to a fine of not less than \$25 nor more than \$300 and the costs of prosecution, and in default of payment of said fine and costs shall undergo imprisonment in the Perry County Prison for a period of not less than seven days nor more than 30 days

SECTION 3. The provisions of this Ordinance are severable, and if any word, words, part, parts, provision, section, sentence or clause shall be declared illegal, invalid, or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such illegality, invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect or impair any of the remaining words, parts, provisions, sections, sentences or clauses of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared to be the intent of the Borough Council that this Ordinance would have been adopted if such illegal, invalid or unconstitutional word, words, part, parts, provisions, sections, sentences or clauses had not been included herein.

SECTION 4. Enforcement of this Ordinance shall be done pursuant to Ordinance #2011-2, relating to the Office of Code Enforcement.
